

Troop 1128 Leadership Agreement – Den Chief 1 (DC1)

Leadership Credit: This position is for first time Den Chiefs and earns leadership credit for Star, Life or Eagle rank, if served successfully.

Qualifications: Is an older Boy Scout. Selected by the Senior Patrol Leader and Scoutmaster at the request of the Cubmaster. Approved by the Cubmaster and Pack Committee for recommendation to the Den Leader. Registered as a youth member of a troop.

Den Chief Responsibilities:

- Know the purposes of Cub Scouting
- Help Cub Scouts achieve the purposes of Cub Scouting
- Serve as the activities assistant at den meetings
- Set a good example through attitude and uniforming
- Be a friend to the boys in the den
- Help lead weekly den meetings (At least one per month)
- Help the den in its part of the monthly pack meeting
- Know the importance of the monthly theme and pack meeting plans
- Meet regularly with the den leader to review den and pack meeting plans
- Meet as needed with adult members of the den, pack, and troop
- Receive training from the den leader (and Cubmaster or assistant Cubmaster)
- Encourage Cub Scouts to become Webelos Scouts when they are eligible
- Help the denner and assistant denner to be leaders
- Be Active in the Troop
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Demonstrate Scout Spirit in everything I do
- Attend ILST-1, BSA Den Chief Training online course and the Troop 1128 Den Chief Training
- Serve the Pack faithfully for one scouting year
- Stay in communication with the Den Chief Coordinator
 - Take attendance at each Den/Pack Meeting and send to Den Leader and Den Chief Coordinator
 - Communicate progress toward the Den Chief Service Award to the Den Chief Coordinator
 - Attend Troop 1128 Den Chief Leadership meeting once per month
