

## Troop 1128 Leadership Agreement – Patrol Leader (PL)

To be elected to this position, a Scout must have earned the rank of First Class, attended a pre-election SPL/PL candidate meeting and at some point completed the Introduction to Leadership course (formerly JLT). This position earns leadership credit for Star, Life or Eagle rank, if served successfully.

On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to:

- Regularly and enthusiastically attend, and lead my patrol at, troop meetings and activities
- Regularly plan and run patrol meetings and activities
- Regularly represent my patrol at Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC) meetings, including the PLC planning meeting for the term, and during the spring term the annual program planning conference
- Lead my patrol at Goshen (spring term only)
- Inform the SPL and my PASM, and arrange for other youth leadership for my patrol, if it is necessary for me to be absent from a troop meeting or activity
- Appoint and train other patrol-level youth leaders (with the advice of my PASM) and assure they carry out their responsibilities
- Give each Scout a chance to do some leading in the Patrol
- Promote strong patrol spirit and identity by consistently using my patrol name, emblem, and cheer
- Make a special effort to be a good friend to each Scout in my Patrol
- Continue my own advancement and help the Scouts in my patrol advance to First Class
- Assure timely and clear communication of troop and patrol activities to the Scouts in my patrol
- Set a good example
- Proudly and correctly wear my Scout uniform and encourage the Scouts in my patrol to do the same
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law in my daily life
- Meet the troop's requirements for being considered an "active" Scout
- Use the Patrol Leader Handbook as a resource, faithfully maintain the patrol's record book, and pass both on to my successor (or pay for replacements if I lose them)
