

## Medical Information for Re-Chartering

Dear Troop 1128 Parents,

Along with the 2019 re-chartering forms, medical forms for 2019 are also due for all Scouts and Scouters. This applies even if you or your son recently joined the troop and you filled out 2018 forms. The forms are available at <http://www.troop1128.org/resources/forms/>.

We will need these forms by December 31, 2018:

1. Authorization to Monitor Medications (2 pages) (for Scouts only)
2. Part A (1 page)
3. Part B (2 pages)

These forms **do not** require a physician's signature.

We require the Part A and Part B health forms for any adult who attends an overnight outing. For adults, item 1, the Authorization to Monitor Medications, is not required.

We will also collect Part C if you or your son has had an annual physical since summer camp. Part C is only required for trips greater than 72 hours in length. Accordingly, it is not due until just prior to summer camp, but we will gladly accept the form whenever the physical exam is performed.

You can either send these forms to us electronically or bring hard copies to any troop meeting before the end of the year.

For some families who have a change in insurance or receive a new card in January please note that we also require a copy (front side and back side) of your health insurance card, as stated on the BSA form Part B.

Again, your son's physical (Form C) follows the annual date based on the date of his exam. **All the other forms are due December 31, 2018.**
