Meals	N/A	No self-serve buffet meals/shared drinks. Clean and disinfect all cooking/serving gear after each use. 6' distance through meal prep and eating. Cook wears gloves and facial covering during preparation and serving.	No self-serve buffet meals/shared drinks. Meals shall be simple, backpacking-type meals that just involve boiling water. <u>Scouts bring their own mess kits</u> . Clean and disinfect all cooking/serving gear and mess kits after each use. 6' distance through meal prep and eating. Cook wears gloves and facial covering during preparation and serving.
